



RICE International Relief Organization Timeline 2005-2010

2005

- RICE was formed as a non profit.
- PHUKET, THAILAND RICE helped with the Tsunami disaster. Had over 18 volunteers. Helped: Construction of homes, provided bulk food and medical supplies for survivors.
- KATRINA, MISSISSIPI RICE opened up a medical clinic. Had volunteer nurses and doc's. We supplied backpacks, food, and medicines for the children and other survivors. RICE also helped rebuild homes.

2006

- UGANDA RICE provided the organization 'Global Refugee International' with donated prescription medicines .
- BURMA and THAILAND RICE planned, organized, and conducted a four day workshop with expert partnering organizations. RICE went alongside Free Burma Rangers and Partners Development and Relief.

2007

- MEXICO RICE supplied OTC meds to Calvary church Pomona for their trip.
- MASAI, KENYA RICE supplied OTC meds to Calvary Chapel of Chino Hills.
- NICARAGUA RICE provided OTC's
- UGANDA RICE provided WATATO(organization who helps rescue orphaned children) Meds, baby supplies, vitamins and first aid kits.

2008

- MALI, AFRICA RICE supplied children's vitamins and first aid kits.
- ETHIOPIA RICE packed and sent OTC meds for org. headed to Ethiopia.
- PHILLIPINES RICE did a medical and dental outreach. Packed two full duffle bags of OTC medicines.
- HAITI RICE shipped and supplied eight boxes of OTC Medicines

2009

- THAILAND RICE provided food, water, medical supplies and medical clinics on this trip
- NAIROBI, KENYA RICE held a 3 day workshop to educate the people and provide food.
- SUDAN RICE held English workshop and provided food.
- PISCO, PERU RICE held a 9 day medical clinic.

2010

- ISRAEL RICE sent two members of RICE alongside another NGO to help build shelters for the people, and give medicines to the elderly Holocaust survivors.
- CARREFOUR, HAITI RICE packed the org. Encompass Ministries with 100 water filtration bottles, 5 filtration pumps, as well as 5 filtration bags to give to their orphanage there and feeding program to help fight the cholera outbreak.
